

Paradox


• A self-contradictory statement. Two ideas held together, that can't both be true.

Paradoxes

We want our President to be:

- Powerful
 -but we fear abuse of power
- Relatable ("like us"; a regular guy)
 - o ...but also extraordinary, smart, and special
- Visionary and creative, willing to shake things up
 -but change makes us uncomfortable don't change the things I like.
- Above politics ("nonpartisan")
 - but a masterful politician, great at working with Congress and helping the party





Chief Guardian of the Economy

Helps make sure the economy runs smoothly



Commander in Chief

Directs military



Chief Legislator

- Sets public policy agenda
- Inaugural Address
- State of the Union Address
 - (required by the Constitution)





Chief Executive

- Executes the laws
- Directs the Federal Bureaucracy (like the CEO of a company)



Chief Citizen


• Celebrates with nation. Morns with nation. Represents interest of all the people.






Chief of Party

Main architect of US Foreign Policy









Chief of State
